Flamenco Vivo Carlota Santana presents VOCES DE ANDALUCIA, a three-part suite of contemporary flamenco dance and music inspired by the cultural richness of Andalucia, the region of Spain known as "the cradle of flamenco."

Voces – "voices" – explores this land of inspiration through two Andalusian-born artists, Pablo Picasso and the playwright-poet Federico Garcia Lorca. Featuring the world premiere *PiCa*, Susana di Palma's dance/fantasy about Picasso; *Federico*, a celebration of Federico Garcia Lorca's creative genius and his profound connection to flamenco and its peoples; and *Canciones Populares*, an adaption of Lorca verses, in a world premiere instrumental/vocal composition by Gaspar Rodriguez.

The program also includes *Angeles II*, choreographed and performed by British National Dance Award nominee Ángel Muñoz, praised by The New York Times for his "spontaneity, invention and surprise."
