Leonardo is NDI's first Artist-in-Residence and has been working with NDI for 2019-2020. No tap shoes are necessary to participate in the class!

This class ends with a performance of the NDI Celebration Team dancers from Summer Institute 2019, dancing a tap piece choreographed by Leonardo Sandoval and composed by Gregory Richardson.
