As we begin the New Year, now 12 days in, Dance/NYC celebrates some special moments from 2012. Here are 12:

#### Dance/NYC:

- 1) Responds to Hurricane Sandy by launching The Mertz Gilmore Foundation's <u>NYC Dance Response Fund</u>, as featured in <u>The New York Times</u>.
- 2) Publishes <u>Discovering Fiscally Sponsored NYC Dancemakers</u>, extending our <u>State of NYC Dance</u> research to underrepresented artists. Read more in the <u>Wall Street Journal</u> and <u>Chronicle of Philanthropy</u>.
- 3) Releases the Dance/NYC Junior Committee's <u>Dance Workforce Census: Earnings Among Individuals, 21-35</u> through <u>Crain's New York Business</u>. Find more Dance/NYC research at <u>DanceNYC.org</u>.
- 4) Uses the Workforce Census to make the case for healthcare options, including a Ryan Community Health Network initiative for NYC dance.
- 5) Reaches aging NYC dance artists through a <u>Still Kicking</u> town hall. Watch Dance/NYC events on <u>DanceNYC.org</u>.
- 6) <u>Kickstarts NYC Dance</u> with crowdfunding partners <u>Kickstarter</u> and <u>USA Projects</u>. The Washington Post's "<u>Dance is Kickstarter's Most Successful Category</u>," cites Dance/NYC as its example of "advocates... paying attention."
- 7) Facilitates resource sharing in NYC dance with <u>OurGoods</u> and Fourth Arts Block. See our <u>Connect the Blocks</u> town hall.
- 8) Sparks critical debate on the state of NYC dance press, including features in The Star-Ledger and Dance Magazine.
- 10) As producing partner, brings the New York Dance and Performance Awards (The Bessies) back to the legendary Apollo Theater.
- 9) Joins <u>It Gets Better</u> video campaign to offer messages of hope to LGBT youth. See NYC dance videos at <u>Skynova TV</u>, and read more in <u>Gay City News</u>.
- 11) Grows DanceNYC.org's registered users by 100%--expanding the online footprint for NYC dance. Register here to post your free listings or ads. Subscribe to our e-newsletter at DanceNYC.org.
