Funding for Nonprofit Dance

- Importance of City, State, and Federal
- Vitality of institutional support
- Resourcefulness of the sector in achieving earned income
- Variation in income sources by budget size



Smaller Nonprofit Dancemaker Story: Start Up Culture

- Diverse income portfolios
- Significant in kind resources barter economy
- Relatively low numbers of fulland part-time staff
- High use of independent contractors/volunteers
- High level of new work creation










Dynamics of Resourcefulness: Average Annual Expenditures















Percentage of Organizations with Operating Deficits





Percentage of Organizations with Negative Liquid Unrestricted Net Assets







Average Earned Income by Type and Size—2010




